Alfred L. Lopez, age 81, died Sunday, November 25, 2012. A resident of Rose Township for 30 years, Al was born in Hamtramck on October 25, 1931, to Juan Manuel and Julia Stachurski Lopez, the second of four children. His parents and his sister, Delores Arnold, predeceased him. Al is survived by his wife, Nancy, his daughter Lynda Glowczewski (Michael), of Fraser, his sons David of Grand Rapids and Robert of Long Beach, CA. He leaves two loving grandchildren, Michael Glowczewski of Frederick, MD, and Amanda Rapp (David) of Royal Oak, and two step-grandsons, Jonah Kubicek and Asher Howarth of Royal Oak. He is also survived by his brothers Thomas (Marika) of Fort Edward, NY, and Raymon (Sandy) of South Lyon.

Al served the United States in the Air Force and then attended Lawrence Institute of Technology, receiving a bachelor of science degree in architecture. He has worked as a structural engineer since 1961 when he became a Professional Engineer. He began his own business as Lopez Engineering in 1971. That business continues in Holly, carried on by two professional engineers and his daughter, Lynda.

Al has served his community over the years as a member of the planning commission in both Springfield and Rose townships, as a member of Davisburg Rotary Club, and as a member of Golden Light Spiritualist Church. The family will receive friends at Dryer Funeral Home in Holly on Thursday, November 29 from 3 to 8 pm. Memorial service will take place there on Friday, November 30, at 10:30 am.
