Amos J Bradsher, 81, of Holly, Michigan passed away peacefully on March 29, 2021. “ MY MEMORIES OF AMOS

*It was the summer of 1952 and our family had just moved to Tinsman road. Although Karen was the first Bradsher I met, it was Amos who followed shortly after that.*

*Coming into the Bradsher yard, brother Gary and I saw stressed out Amo in one of their fields. He was some distance from the house, and he asked us if we knew how to drive a tractor. Gary said yes and with a few instructions, Gary drove the tractor out of the field and into the driveway and right through the back of the family garage.*

*The three of us trying to get the front of the tractor up the wall and back into the garage is another story. It was a day fixing the back of the garage before Amos's dad Harry got home from work. You can guess.....he noticed both tractor and garage damage.*

*Just another note: We were always playing war games in the neighborhood with Beebe guns. As Amos kept popping his head up over the bale of hay he was hiding behind, at the exact time his head popped up, I pulled the trigger and shot him in the eye. There was so much blood that we couldn't see where the shot ended. It was soon determined that the Beebe was stuck in his lower lid. Sister Jeanne drove Amos to the doctor in Fenton.
