



Annabelle M. Dziuba

April 16, 1924 - October 21, 2022

Annabelle M. Dziuba, age 98 1/2, of Davisburg passed away quietly at home surrounded by her devoted family. Annabelle was a great homemaker and a hard worker who excelled at cooking, gardening, sewing, bookkeeping, and caring for her seven children while always keeping her Irish sense of humor. She was a devout Catholic with firm beliefs and longtime parishioner of St. Rita's in Holly, starting with Father Cyril Rancourt, who as a new priest, had baptized several of her children when they lived in Detroit and attended St. Bonafice. She was the daughter of Martin and Mary Minton of Bolton, MI and one of eleven children. She attended the school built by her Irish grandfather. "Dear", as she was called by her family, wanted to be a nurse but when the war broke out, she went to live with an older sister in Detroit, and became a young "Rosie the Riveter" at age 17. She recalled how she had to take several trolley cars and bus to get to and from work, making parts for fighter planes. Later she went back to work on the family farm to help while her brothers were in the service. Annabelle met her husband Felix at a dance in Posen, MI, married in Alpena, MI on January 17, 1944, and had two small children before he was drafted and sent to Korea in WWII. After the war, they moved to Detroit and then Clawson before settling in Davisburg with their seven children, who all attended Holly Schools before going on to college. Annabelle will be dearly missed by her family and friends.
