Annabelle Zager, 90, died Wednesday, March 18, 2015 at her home in Keene, TX. She was born November 13, 1924 in Akron, OH to George and Anna Vartenuk. 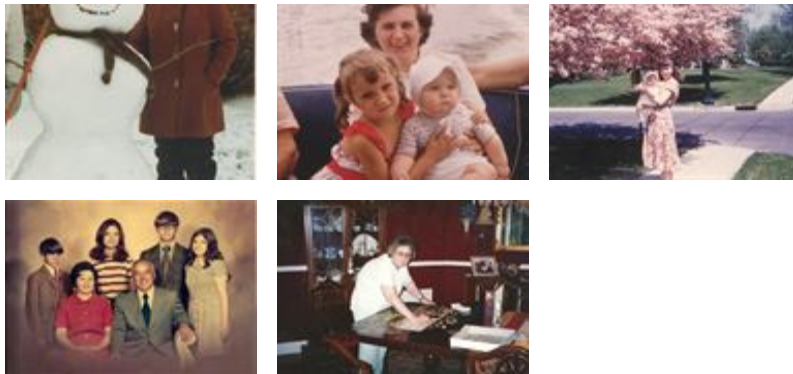
