Anthony John Neuwirth, 89, formerly of Lake Placid, Florida, died peacefully on September 9, 2015 in Murrieta, California. Tony was born December 23, 1925 in Niagara, Wisconsin to Anton John Neuwirth and Adeline (Stefan) Neuwirth, one of six children. He spent most of his life living in the metro Detroit area and later in Gaylord, Michigan. Tony was recognized as a gifted learner in childhood, graduated high school at age 16, and went on to earn a Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering and Master's degree in Industrial Administration from University of Michigan.
