Barbara was born November 27, 1938, in Pontiac, Michigan, to parents Edward and Eleanor Bethune and is survived by her two younger sisters, Mary Ann Bethune and KJ Bethune. In 1962 Barb married Walter Brown at the Davisburg Methodist Church and celebrated 62 years of marriage at the time of her death. She is survived by her husband, Walter, two daughters -- Jacqueline Campbell (Scott Campbell) and Jennifer Mayfield (Kevin Mayfield) -- four grandchildren -- Kevin and Dylan Mayfield, Katie Campbell-Magar and Jeffrey Campbell -- and one great-granddaughter -- Ava Campbell-Magar.

Barb and her family moved from Pontiac, Michigan to Big Lake near Davisburg when she was in grade school and attended Covell School -- a one-room country schoolhouse -- and later Davisburg Elementary School. Barbara is a graduate of the Holly High School, Class of 1957. After high school she attended Michigan State University, graduating in 1961 with a bachelor's degree in education and later receiving a master's degree in education from Central Michigan University. She began her teaching career at Clarkston High School in the fall of 1961 and later taught at Holly High School and Fenton High School, where she taught for over thirty years.

Barb was a long-time, active member and elder of the Holly Presbyterian Church, and taught both Sunday School and Adult Sunday School for many years. She was also the leader of a girl scout troop while her two daughters were active in scouting.

Barb enjoyed teaching, reading mystery novels, camping, road trips -- especially driving in the Appalachian Mountains -- and a warm fire in the fireplace with a kitty on her lap.
