Bobbie C. Stallcup, age 83 of Holly and Au Gres crossed his final finish line peacefully on September 11, 2014 with his family and companion Barbara Soloko at his side. Bob was born in Flint, Mi. to the late Burlus W. and Gladys (Clark) Stallcup. He grew up in the Flint and Grand Blanc area and graduated from Grand Blanc High School in 1949 and served as a Hospital Corpsman in the U.S. Navy from 1951 to 1955. He married Dolores Hoffman on December 20, 1952 who preceded him in death August 2007.
