Bonnie Giammarco, age 78, of Holly passed away on September 27, 2024. Bonnie was born in Flint, MI the daughter of Drum Major Arthur Skeels and songstress/ piano player Barbara (Thomas). Music was always a part of her life and she graduated from Central Michigan University in music education. She then started her career as an elementary music teacher for the Flint Public Schools, marrying the love of her life Gerald until taking time off to raise her girls. During this time, she taught piano out of her home, volunteered at the schools, and helped develop the music program at Halsey United Methodist Church. When she returned to school she volunteered in the Holly High School theatre department working on the High school musicals. Completing her master's, she later joined the team as a special education teacher. She also taught choir and completed a second masters becoming a high school counselor for the remainder of her career. She continued to develop special music programs and served as choir director at Halsey Church in her "retirement". Left to celebrate her memory are her daughters Tiffany Giammarco, Stephanie Allwelt (Thomas), and Joey Escamilla (Chris), her grandchildren Thaeden, Crystal, David, Benny, and Magial, her cats the stealthy Stella and Cheeto-eating Tumi, her wonderful cousins, many students and dreamers whose lives she touched. She is preceded in death by her husband Gerald, her parents Arthur Skeels, Barbara, and Andrew Garant. 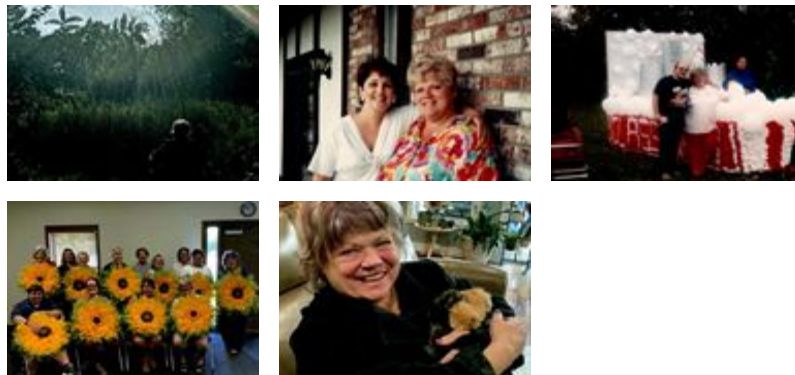
