August 28, 1941 - February 11, 2024

Carole F. Munoz, age 82, of West Branch died on Sunday, February 11, 2024, in West Branch. Born daughter of the late Wallace and Margaret (Styles) Brown on August 28, 1941, in Tell City, Indiana where she was raised. Carole later moved to Michigan, where she raised her family. 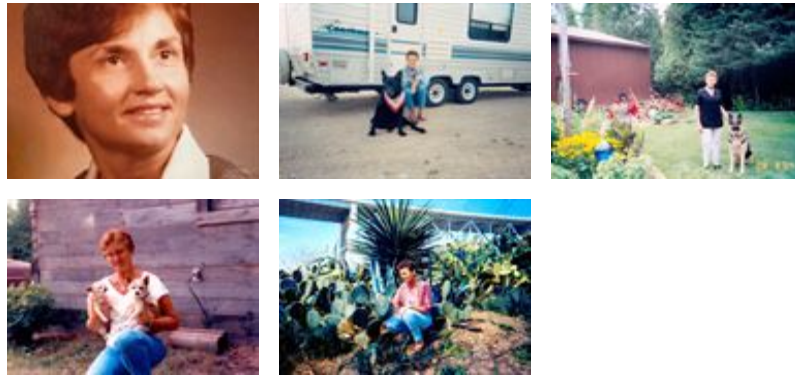

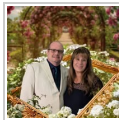

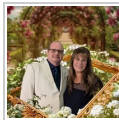
