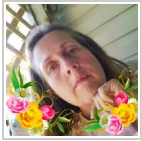

as she came home from her 3-11 shift. She passed first time. A few
years later we studied for her RN. Yes, first test she passed and

graduated N. Salinas High School earning a fully paid 4 year
academic scholarship. Then off to college. We were family and a
team.
So I had grown up without a legal guardian. We were pals. We all
were.
