



Donald C. MacKenzie

July 1, 1943 - May 11, 2023

Donald Charles MacKenzie, aged 79, died suddenly at his home on May 11, 2023.

Don was born in Holly, Michigan to Shirley and Rolland “Mac” MacKenzie on July 1st, 1943. He grew up on Buckhorn Lake in Rose Center, one of 7 children, and attended school in a one-room schoolhouse. Don graduated from Holly High School in 1961 as a student-athlete earning varsity letters in basketball, football, track, baseball, and golf. He graduated with high honors earning a degree in Pharmacy from Ferris State University. He joined his father, Mac, and brother, Jack at Mac’s Pharmacy where they worked together until Mac retired and Don bought the store. Years later he sold Mac’s Pharmacy to Rite Aid and went to work for Rite Aid in Holly.

Don was an excellent golfer and a member first with his family at Atlas Valley Country Club and later at Spring Meadows Country Club. He hunted, fished, played cards, and bowled over the years with his many friends. He will be missed by his family, friends, and all the customers he served over the years, but most of all his grandchildren. He tried to make their every athletic event from water polo, basketball, soccer, and baseball games.

Don was preceded in death by his mother and father, Mac and Shirley MacKenzie, his brother, Jack MacKenzie, and sister, Norma Baker.

He is survived by his wife of nearly 41 years, Susan MacKenzie, his children John Patrick (Kate) MacKenzie, Meghan MacKenzie (Robert Zalewski), Stephanie Bennett, and Rob Bennett, grandchildren Cecelia, Max, Josephine, Francesca, Karl, and Veronica Zalewski and Rocco Caponigro, Also, his sisters: Sally Schultz, Sandy (George) McDaniel, Karen Freeman, Kathy McKenney, and many nieces and nephews.

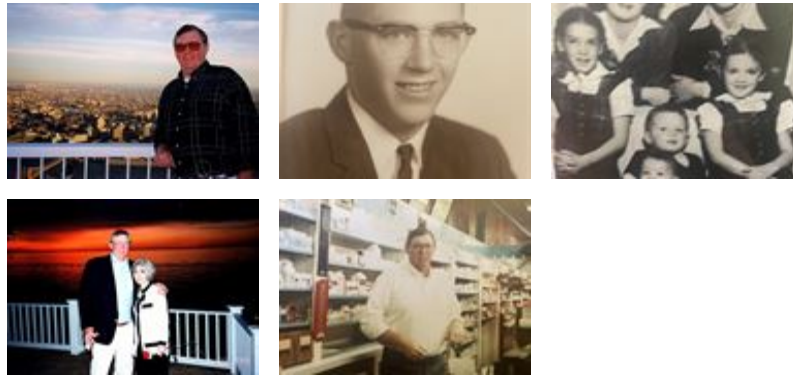
