The Schofer family has been a long-time supporter of Davisburg Troop 192, chartered in 1969 by the Davisburg Rotary. Circa 1979, the Schofer's moved to Davisburg from California. Before their relocation, Glen Schofer achieved the rank of Eagle on 6/27/1978 at age 15. On their arrival in Davisburg, Glen joined Troop 192 and eventually held the position of Junior Assistant Scoutmaster where he assisted youths with character development and supported scout Robert Charlton to achieve his Eagle rank in 1983, which was the first Eagle rank advancement in Troop 192. Glen's father Al Schofer joined the Davisburg Rotary and continued support of Troop 192 as the Charter Organization Representative for many years until his death 9/14/2012. Al passed away during construction of the Eagle Project "Wetland Overlook," located behind the Davisburg Cemetery on Broadway, so Denton Humphreys dedicated his project in Al's memory, and later where the family placed Al's ashes. Al's son Glen passed away recently on 2/23/2025 from cancer. The family asked for donations to American Cancer Society. In Glen's memory, Troop 192 is donating \$250 to fight cancer.
