



Glenn D. Fazenbaker

November 23, 1946 - April 6, 2023

Glenn David Fazenbaker, well known contrarian, storyteller, and mediocre dirt track racer passed away April 6, 2023 at his home in Davisburg surrounded by Theresa, his wife of 54 years, his son Don, and his daughter Chris. Glenn was predeceased by his youngest son David. He leaves behind a loving family that includes two daughters-in-law, Leslie and Kim, his grandson Karson, his brother Harry, and a NASCAR die-cast collection unrivaled by any sensible man. Glenn was born November 23, 1946 to Frank and Cora Fazenbaker and spent his youth in the hills of western Maryland hunting deer and wrecking cars. In 1968, Glenn decided making a living building cars was preferable to working in coal mines so he moved to Michigan. He often regaled his family with the story of this move by reminding them the only thing he had to his name at the time was \$500, a new deer rifle, and a pig. He spent the money, wore out the rifle, and ate the pig. There was no going back. He took a job at General Motors where he met his future bride and spent the next 30 years harassing management and many of his UAW cohorts until his retirement. In retirement, Glenn spent his time hunting, riding his prized Harley Davidson, and attending NASCAR races. Glenn suffered a stroke in 2006 robbing him his ability to walk and speak except for a couple off color phrases that cannot be repeated here. His diminished capacity however did not deter him from harassing people for his own entertainment. He often prided himself on the aggravation he caused others. It was his way of showing love, making his wife Theresa the most loved of all. Those who loved him also knew the

feeling of wanting to slap him. He will be missed. Glenn's family will be greeting visitors on Monday, April 10, 2023 from 2 PM until 8 PM at Dryer Funeral Home in Holly, with burial on Tuesday, April 11th at Davisburg Cemetery at 1PM.

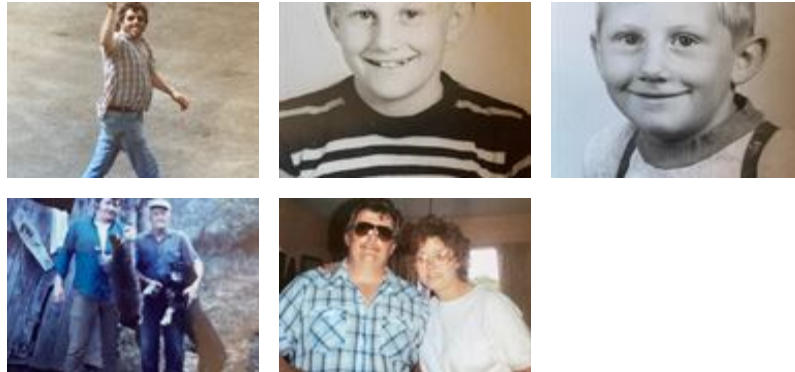
