Jeff Snowden, Age 55 passed away at Genesys Hospital on May 17, 2017. Born in Flint, MI, he lived his life in the Fenton and Holly area. 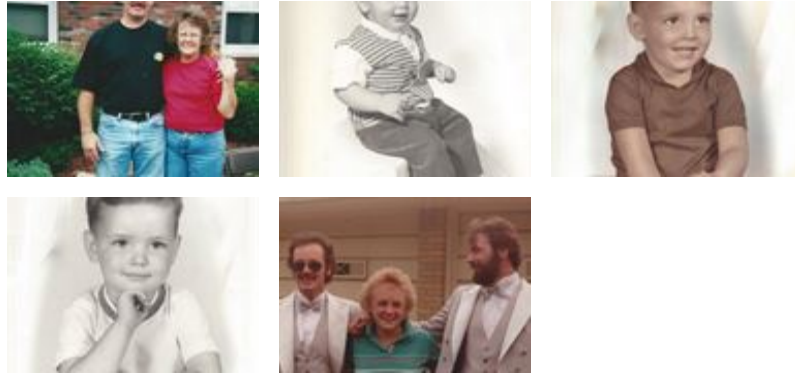
