June 16, 1947 - June 8, 2020

Jesse B. Moss III, age 72, of Flint died Mon. June 8, 2020. He was born on June 16, 1947 to Jesse Jr. and Martha (McCumsey) Moss. He served as a Sergeant in the US Army in Germany during the Vietnam War and was retired from General Motors. He had a love for Jesus and teaching the bible.
