Jill was a fiercely passionate advocate for abused and neglected children and devoted her life to this work, side-by-side with her husband of 45 years, Robert Ennis, who founded Ennis Center for Children, a non-profit children's services agency. Jill was also an artist and lover of beauty. She painted, carefully tended to her flowers and garden, was a wonderful cook and decorator. Gifted with words, she wrote and spoke in a way that captivated any audience. No one told a story like Jill. She radiated a natural grace, elegance, and style. Unfailingly kind, Jill filled every space with warmth. Above all else, Jill adored her family. Along with her husband Robert, Jill is survived by her daughter, Erin Covert (Andrew), son Robert Ennis Jr. (Angie), grandchildren Ryan, Hannah, Okera, Ashley, and Robert, plus canine companion Charly, several cousins, longtime friends, and her Ennis Center for Children family. Jill was preceded in death by her parents and brother, Jeff Whitacre. Funeral services will be held at The River Church, Holly on Wed. May 25, 2022 from 10 AM to 12 Noon.
