



## Jonathan B. LaFalce

October 21, 1958 - November 21, 2022

Jonathan Blair LaFalce, age 64, of Holly, MI passed away at home surrounded by family on November 21, 2022 after a 16 month battle with Acute Myeloid Leukemia.

Jon was born on October 21, 1958 to John A. and Joyce B. LaFalce in Grosse Pointe, Michigan. He graduated from Grand Blanc High School in 1976. He served in the United States Air Force from 1978-1982, specializing in aircraft electrical systems. He then earned his Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Michigan-Flint. After 31 years of service as an engineer and project manager in the Heavy Vehicle Systems department of Rockwell/ZF, he retired in January 2022.

Jon married his college sweetheart Dr. Teryl J. May-LaFalce in 1990 and had two sons, Travis AG LaFalce and Trevor AJ LaFalce. They adopted three dogs from Adopt-A-Pet in Fenton, MI; Maggie May, Bullseye Todd and Lilly Quinn. Jon was a true Blue Michigan Football fan and shared his love of the game with his boys at the Big House in Ann Arbor.

Jon had a wicked sense of humor, a love for all things antique especially history books. He also collected snarky t-shirts and banana stickers. He loved genealogy and fishing with his family and friends.

He is survived by his wife Teryl, sons Travis and Trevor, mother Joyce B. LaFalce, brothers Brian (Linda) and David, sister Lynne LaFalce, many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, sisters-in-law, and many friends and co-workers.
