Kevin Keith Trimbath, age 57, died July 5, 2021 in Holly, Michigan, after battling cancer. As a devout Christian and servant of God, he spent a lifetime promoting the welfare and happiness of others.

At his request, a private family burial service will be held at the Great Lakes National Cemetery, Thursday, July 8 at 9a.m.

Kevin spent nearly 20 years in criminal justice system as police officer, detective and field training officer in Colorado, he also served as a Security Specialist in the U.S. Air Force, Colorado National Guard, and with the United Nations Peacekeeping Forces as a civilian contractor.

He is remembered as the driving force for establishing and funding a hospital and orphanage in a small village in India.

Kevin is survived by his parents Earl and Darlene Trimbath, siblings Daniel, Sheri (Crowe), Karyne (Sanborn), nephew Matthew (McClary), and nieces Heather (McClary), Jozee (Keating), Megan (Kage). Aunts and uncles Dolores and Ron (Stack), Mike and Connie (Ware), Dave and Jesse (Trimbath) and cousins Doug, Dan, Donnie, Diane, Darlene, Patrick and Rebecca.

Kevin is preceded in death by his sister Kelly, niece Kora, grandparents Earl and Ellen Trimbath, and Kenneth and Mildred Ware.

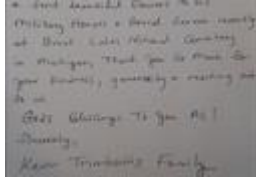

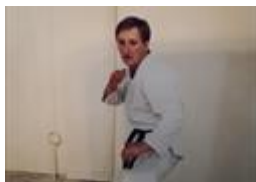

“ I too had the distinct honor and privilege of serving with Kevin in the Colorado Air National Guard, with the 140th Security Police Squadron. I deployed with Kevin to Desert Storm and on numerous additional deployments for annual training. Kevin made the decision to leave the military to pursue other career opportunities, I chose to make a career out the military and retired after thirty years. The reason I mention this is that in my thirty year career there were very few NCO’s who were held in such high regard as Kevin. Kevin epitomized the spirit of leadership, integrity and honesty. In conversation Kevin was often referred to as, “The Sergeant,” other individuals may have held the same rank but few could compare to Kevin’s conduct and character.
