Linda Living-Hawley, age 74 of Fenton and Holly, died Thurs. Nov. 9, 2023. She was born in Holly on Dec. 29, 1948 to Reece and Wanda (Haddon) Living. Linda was a registered nurse for 42 years at many hospitals including McPherson Hospital, Pontiac General Hospital, hospitals in Hawaii, Harper Hospital, Henry Ford Hospital, Crittenton Hospital, and Trinity Hospital in Howell as a hospice nurse. She had a calling for ministry and she was the pastor of the Tyrone Community Presbyterian Church for 10 years, retiring in 2019. Linda wrote children's books and had a degree in mental health and taught at Oakland Community College, Highland Lakes. She was a chaplain for the Waterford Twp. Fire Dept. and taught stress management for several fire departments. Linda was a counselor to anyone who walked on to her property. She saved people's lives and she saved people's souls. Everything she did, she did her way which was the right way on the first try. Surviving are her husband David; mother Wanda Living; brother Michael, sister Reisa, and many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, and cousins. Memorial services will be held at 1:00 PM Sat. 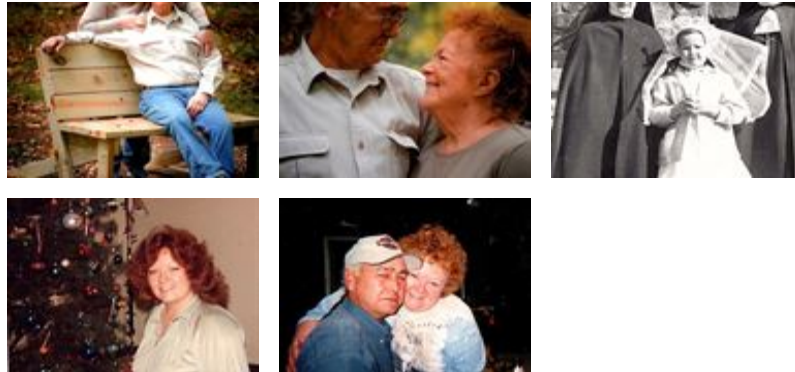
