Lois Caryl Obituary

It is with immense sadness that we announce the death of our cherished mother, Lois L. Caryl (nee Schelp) on December 17, 2017, at the age of 94. Visitation will be held on Tuesday, December 19 from 3-5 pm and 7-9 pm at the Dryer Funeral Home, Holly. Funeral services will be held Wednesday, December 20 at 11:00 a.m., the Rev. Sharlyn Gates officiating. Lois was born in Holly, February 1, 1923, the daughter of Marion and Herman Schelp. She graduated from Holly High School in 1940 and married Melvin E. Caryl on May 17, 1947; he preceded her in death 1997. Mrs. Caryl was a life member of the Northwest Oakland County Historical Society and a member of Calvary Methodist Church – Holly. Surviving are her two children; Cindy (Bruce) Sommers, of Liberty Township, OH and Jeff Caryl (fiancée Diana Rushlow) of Holly, grandchildren; Jason, Jennifer, Brendon and Alex, great-grand children, nieces, special cousin – Beth Dryer and many dear friends. Mrs. Caryl began her early career as a comptometer at the AC Spark Plug, Flint and also worked in retail sales at Smith Bridgmans, Grand Blanc. 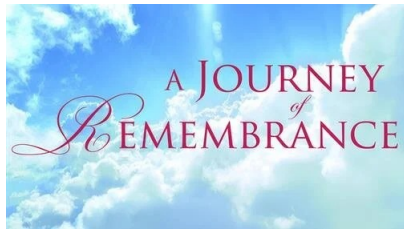
