



## Marcella (Vizina) Fahlgren

December 14, 1919 - April 12, 2021

Marcella (Vizina) Fahlgren, age 101, of Holly, formerly of Baraga, died April 12, 2021. She was born in Baraga on Dec. 14, 1919 to Joseph and Eliza (Foucalt) Vizina.
