Margaret Rainey, 80, of Holly, Michigan passed away with her family by her side on January 17, 2017 from complications of open heart surgery. She was preceded in death by her husband of 43 years, Ronald R. Rainey. A memorial service will be held at the Holly Presbyterian Church on January 28 at 11:00 am with fellowship and lunch following the service.
