Mo was a friend to all he met and particularly enjoyed golfing with friends, woodworking, keeping his lawn and yard perfected, spending time with his beloved dogs and especially loved being around his family. He supported all of Judi's hobbies providing woodworking and gardening labor (he particularly

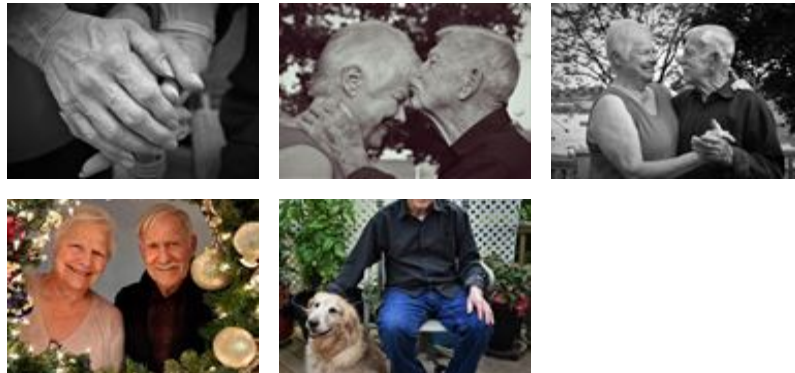

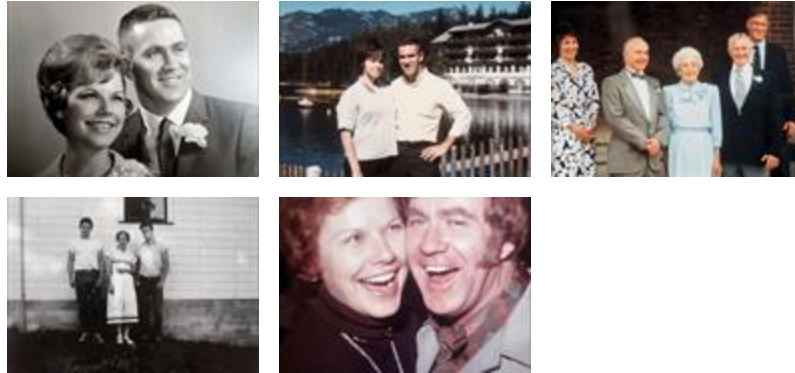
