Orrie "Skip" Oberheim, 91, passed away on May 26, 2024 in Holly, MI.

Skip was born 10/22/1932 in Flint, MI to Orrie F. and Lucille (Cleaver) Oberheim. Skip was a proud veteran of the US Army, serving our nation from 1953-1955. He was stationed at Fort Knox and later sent overseas to protect our country during the Korean War as a sharpshooter and tanker in Germany. He was awarded the National Defense Service Medal. Skip was an avid NASCAR fan, hunter and enjoyed traveling. He was active in his community serving as a past president of the Holly Kiwanis Club, member of the Holly American Legion, 3rd degree Mason of Shriner, member of the Moose, and past commander of the VFW. He had an entrepreneurial mindset. Skip was owner of the IGA in Holly, MI. In Port Charlotte, he created his business, OK Lawn Care, and bought Peter's Restaurant, leaving an everlasting mark on his community.

Skip cherished making memories with his family the most. He married Roslyn Conrad on 5/12/56. They had 5 children, sons; Ted, Frank, Steven, Chris and daughter; Robin. Skip spent his adult years living in Holly, MI and Port Charlotte, FL.

Skip is preceded in death by his wife, Roslyn; parents, Lucille and Orrie; son, Ted; grandchild, Chris, brother-in-law, Tom Stephens; and faithful companions Libby and Jenny.

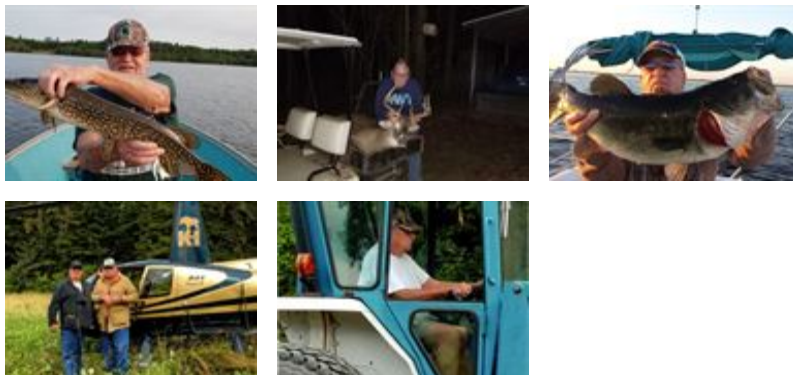
