Robert Edwin Wilson, age 83, of Nokomis, FL died Mon. Oct. 27, 2014. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM Mon. Nov. 3, 2014 at the Dryer Funeral Home, Holly. Burial will be in Lakeside Cemetery, Holly. Visitation will be from 2-5 and 7-9 PM Sun. Mr. Wilson was born in Holly on July 31, 1931, the son of Crowell and Lola (King) Wilson. After retiring as a machinist from Pontiac Motors, Mr. Wilson owned a Yamaha Motorcycle Dealership from 1963 to 1973. He then owned a motorcycle accessory manufacturing business, which was the first in the US to make unbreakable plastic motorcycle fenders. An avid motorcyclist, after retiring, he played with motorcycles and sidecars the rest of his life. He was also a professional drummer, and loved his dogs. He was known to do what he wanted to do, even when it was said that it could not be done. Surviving are 4 children, Robert E. (Denise) Wilson Jr. of Oxford, Vincent (Linda) Wilson of Oxford, Lolamarie Wilson of Lapeer, and Douglas (Tess) Wilson of Clarkston; 9 grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren; and brother Ed Wilson of GA.
