



Sherman A. Beeler

October 23, 1947 - December 23, 2025

Sherman Albert Beeler, age 78, peacefully passed away on Tuesday December 23, 2025 in Grand Blanc, Michigan. Born in Detroit on October 23, 1947, he was the son of Charles Thomas and Ruby Lee (Robertson) Beeler, former husband of Peggy Stone (John) Tegel and Nancy Sanderson Whitaker Cantine.

He was preceded in death by his father and mother, brothers John T. Beeler and Charles D Beeler, sister Ruby R. Beeler, grandson Seth Beeler, and great-grandson Gabriel Beeler.

Sherman moved with his parents to Holly, Michigan in 1954, and attended elementary

school in Davisburg. He graduated from Holly High School in 1966, and attended Wayne

State University 1967-1971, majoring in vocal music. He and Peggy Stone were married in

1970 by Bishop David Collins in the office at Clinton Street Greater Bethlehem Temple in

Detroit. From 1974-2002, he lived in Pontiac. He married Nancy Cantine in 1995 in Holly.

He later lived in Waterford, and finally moved back to the Holly area.

He is well-known for his mellow baritone voice, and sang with the Holly High School Choir,

Wayne State University Men's Glee Club, the Ted Thomas Ensemble, Thurlow Spurr's

Michigan Concert Choir, Voice for Christ Music Ministries, and many other church and local community choirs.

He worked for the Oakland County Road Commission from 1971 to 2000, first in the forestry division, then as Human Relations Coordinator, and then as Personnel Specialist.

He attended Oakland University, Rochester, in the 1990s, majoring in Human Resources.

He was active in Scouting with his children, and was Cubmaster for Pack 66, Clinton Valley Boy Scout Council. He also assisted Peggy with her Girl Scout Troops. Over the years, he participated in many sports and activities, including track, softball, canoeing, volleyball, horseshoes, ping-pong and bowling.

He was baptized in Jesus' name at an early age. Until 1983, he attended the churches that his parents pastored in Holly, particularly Bethlehem Temple Church #4, later renamed Holly Apostolic Church. From 1983-1991, he attended First Open Bible Church in Pontiac, and from 1991-1995, he attended Christian Fellowship Church of Holly, where he was assistant pastor. In the late 1990s he returned to Holly Apostolic Church as an elder for several years, then attended Mt. Zion in Waterford. He returned to Holly Apostolic and became Bishop and Pastor there. His final church affiliation was with the Carpenter's

House Church in Holly, pastored by his son-in-law and daughter, Bradley and Andrea

Teague. His life was centered around the Scriptures.

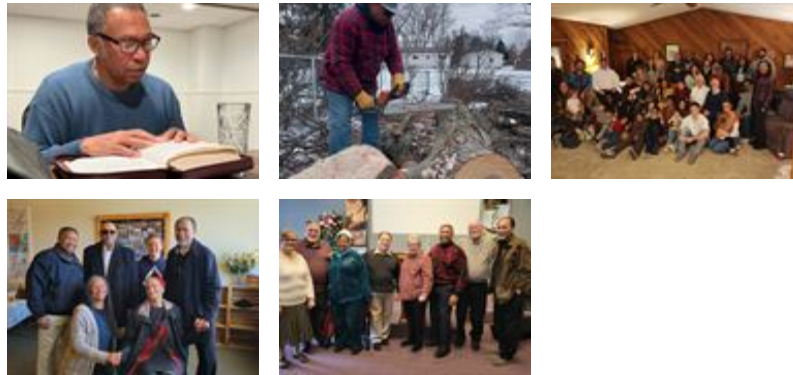

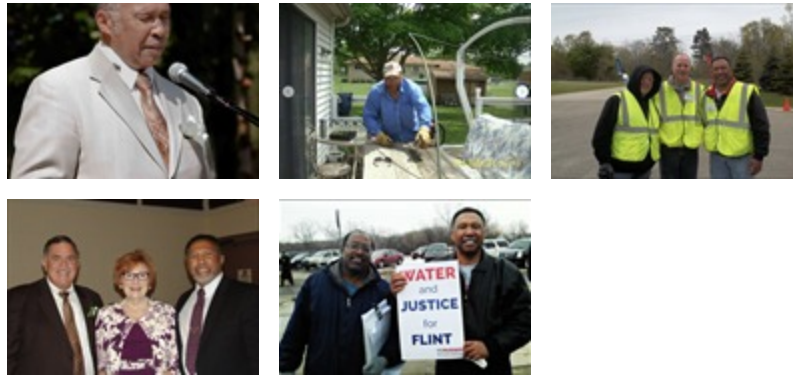
