Stanley Charles Sherman, 97, of Waterford and Holly, passed away peacefully while living at the Inn at Cass Lake Feb. 16, 2017. He was born in Pontiac, MI on Oct. 1, 1919 to the late George and May (Tremper) Sherman. Stanley served in the United States Army during WWII where he served as a medic. He was a proud member of the AFL since 1946 and was President of the Bricklayers Union Local 29 from 1950-1953. In 1954 he became a business agent for the local and served as President of the AFL-CIO of Oakland County from 1955-1957. From 1957-1960 he was the Business Agent for the Laborers Local 1076. From 1966 until his retirement in 1981, he worked as the Trust Investigator for the pension fund for Bricklayers and Laborers. Stanley married Marion L. Cooke , Oct. 24, 1941, and they had 5 loving children. He retired from the bricklayers and the union in Oct. of 1981. He enjoyed golf, hunting, fishing, and spending time with his children and grandchildren. Stanley is the loving father of and survived by his children, David (Kay) Sherman, Sue Ellen (Robert) Holloway, Linda (Joseph) Hadley, and Michele (Matthew) Roberts; daughter-in-law Patricia Sherman; 13 grandchildren; 34 great-grandchildren; and 8 great-great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by Marion L. Cooke Sherman, his wife of 60 years in 2002, his son Frederick in 2014, his brothers Harold, Arnold, and George Sherman, his parents and step-mother Minnie Mascotte Sherman.
