Timothy “Tim” Charles Beebe, of Livonia, passed away on December 2, 2024. He was 64 years old. Born June 18, 1960 in Flint, he was the son of Bryce Arnold and Mary Ann (Vliet) Beebe and lived in Holly, MI until he enlisted in the US armed services. Tim spent seven years in the Army serving as a Sergeant and thirteen years in the Navy, retiring as an Aviation Storekeeper Petty Officer Second Class. Upon retirement from the military, Tim worked in the shipping department for School Tech, volunteered for the VFW National Home, and served as a volunteer firefighter for both Northfield and Pittsfield Townships.
