Wesley Richard Watson, age 35, of Colorado Springs, CO, died Dec. 12, 2012. Funeral services will be held at 1:00 PM Friday, Dec.21, 2012 at the Dryer Funeral Home, Holly. Visitation will be from 11:00 AM until the time of service on Friday. Interment and military honors will be at Great Lakes National Cemetery, Holly. 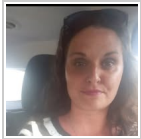
