We write with heavy hearts to announce that William “Bill” George DiSessa, 66, of Holly, Michigan, passed away on May 26, 2024.

Bill was born on October 15, 1957, to Mary Lou Wright and William George Farnum in Flint, Michigan. He was later adopted by Vincent DiSessa, who raised Bill, dutifully and lovingly, with Mary Lou. Bill completed his High School education at George A. Dondero High School. After, he achieved a Bachelor’s Degree in Journalism from Central Michigan University; and he also received a Master’s Degree from the University of Pheonix in Organizational Management.

After graduating from Central Michigan University, he found his way to La Porte, Texas, where he met the love of his life, who would inspire him until the day of his passing: Janie Bais DiSessa. Bill and Janie were married; and after two years, they had a son: Will. Bill’s and Janie’s marriage endured until the day of Bill’s passing—a union that lasted 34 years in this world.

With remarkable creativity and effortless excellence in all his endeavors, Bill’s accomplishments are innumerable. He began his career as a Reporter for the Houston Chronicle before he moved back home to Michigan, where he worked as a Reporter for the Flint Journal. He went on to hold many titles within the State of Michigan, including: Communications Specialist; Manager;

Administrative Manager; and, at the time of his passing, Spokesperson for the Michigan Department of Education. Ever committed to the betterment of our society, Bill also served as an Adjunct Instructor with Madonna University, where he taught Bachelor's- and Master's-level courses that reached students as far as Tianjin Agricultural University in China.

Bill's curiosity could never be contained; and his talent was as limitless as the love he brought to this world. In his free time, Bill was an entrepreneur, who explored his interests as a self-made Product Developer. In this role, he obtained multiple approvals from the United States Patent and Trademark Office for utility patents; and he also developed two mobile apps (each aimed at combating the immense stressors of the COVID-19 pandemic). Using an exquisite mastery of the written word, Bill was also an author, who penned works in the style of screenplay and prose. And in his dedication to serving his community in the Village of Holly, Michigan, Bill was appointed to his local Planning Commission, Historic District Commission, and Zoning Board of Appeals.

There is simply insufficient space to give Bill the tribute that he deserves. He was an athlete, a movie buff, a student of history, an inventor, an artist, and—without a shred of hyperbole—among the greatest fathers that has ever been or ever will be. We take comfort in the knowledge that Bill leaves behind a legacy of love that will live on in those for whom he now waits. He is predeceased by his mother, Mary Lou, his biological father, William, and his sister, Juliet. He is survived by his wife, Janie, his son, Will, his brother, Ronald, his sister, Angela, his brother-in-law, Michael Osborne, his niece, Grace, his adoptive father, Vincent, and many more friends and family members. We will see him again, one day, in a happy eternity.

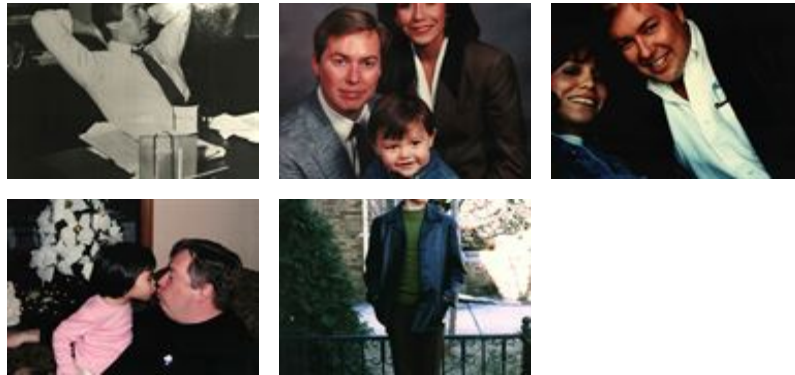


“ Bill and I shared an apartment in the late 1980s. We met as reporters for the Pasadena Citizen. He had gotten the Pasadena beat for the Houston Chronicle by the time we got an apartment. We'd wait until we knew our respective presses were rolling before we talked about whatever stories we had and whether we'd scooped one another. I never scooped him, and with stories that we both covered, he always had details that I didn't. This was reporter school for me, and with every detail he got that I didn't, it made me a better reporter. We also had a rather "Pink Panther" Kato-Clousea thing going in the apartment. If one of us came home later than the other, he would arrive to find a squirt gun on a table by the door. The ensuing water-gun fight not only soaked the apartment but involved water booby traps everywhere. He didn't think it was wise for me to take a job at the much-bigger Odessa paper, believing I should hold out for the Houston Post or Houston Chronicle, but I did it anyway. I should have listened to him. An excellent reporter and fine human being. I'll miss him and our goofy social-media banter.
